- 3) The program has been implemented in such rural areas in India which do not have access to oral health services within a radius of 15 Kms. [If the Dental College is conducting, they must obtain a letter of proof from local Panchayat or A O from the concerned PHC or any concerned authorities that there are no oral health care facilities available, If the local body or any voluntary organization is sponsoring the program it must be mentioned to the Institution that the rural area do not have any approach to Oral health]
- 4) The program has been implemented and has been received in a positive manner;
- 5) The program was initiated and conducted by employees/students of the Dental Teaching Institutions in India.
- 6) The program demonstrates a commitment to employee volunteerism, team work and community oral health service.

7. One type of continuously running community outreach Programme will be considered only once.
