MEMORANDUM OF THE ASSOCIATION

1. NAME

The name of the Association herein after called the “ASSOCIATION” shall be INDIAN ASSOCIATION OF PUBLIC HEALTH DENTISTRY.

2. OBJECTIVES

The Objectives of the Association are:

- a) To popularize and promote the study of Public Health Dentistry and Preventive Dentistry in India and work towards overall goals of improving the oral health of the Public.
- b) To educate the public for the improvement of oral health and popularize and spread the dental education in India.
- c) To promote the Dental profession in all the specialities of Dentistry
- d) To exchange with Dental practitioners in India as well as abroad, the methods for improvement of and relating to the practice of Dentistry, Public Health Dentistry, in particular.
- e) To publish, print journals, periodicals, articles and other literature relating to problems, practice, methods, improvements and other matters related to dentistry, as a whole and related to Public Health Dentistry in particular
- f) To aid and help the members of the Association in procuring for them the necessary raw materials and other articles and equipments required in the practice of Dentistry in India.
- g) To encourage research in dental and allied sciences with grants out of the funds of the Association, by establishing scholarships, prizes or rewards and/or in such other manner as may, from time to time be determined by the Association.
- h) To publish, from time to time, papers embodying dental research conducted by members independently or under the auspices of the Association and the name of the Journal will be Journal of Indian Association of Public Health Dentistry (JIAPHD)
- i) To hold periodic Meetings and Conferences of the members of the Association and of the Dental professionals in general.
- j) To do all such other things as are cognate to the objects of the Association or are incidental in such manner of conducive to the attainment of the above objectives.
- k) To safeguard the interests of the members of the Association.

3. OFFICE

The office of the Association shall be at the seat of the Honorary General Secretary.

4. COMMUNICATION

5. PROFIT OR INCOME CLAUSE

The income to the association through various means specified shall be utilized only for the Association purpose and will not be disbursed among its members or anybody.

RULES & REGULATIONS BYE-LAWS & CODE OF ETHICS

1. NAME

The name of the Association herein after called the “ASSOCIATION” shall be INDIAN ASSOCIATION OF PUBLIC HEALTH DENTISTRY.

2. JURISDICTION

The Jurisdiction of the Association shall cover the entire country.

3. OFFICE

The office of the Association shall be at the seat of the Honorary General Secretary.

4. MEMBERSHIP

The association shall consist of Founder Members, Ordinary members, Life Members, Associate Members, Affiliate Members, Honorary members, Student Members, Institutional/ Corporate members and Emeritus status.

5. ELIGIBILITY

a) FOUNDER MEMBER

The persons who have taken part in promoting the Association shall be its founder Member. Membership for the same is closed.

b) ORDINARY MEMBER:

Any person being registered in Part A of the Indian Dentists Register and possessing **Post-graduate (MDS) qualifications from any recognized Indian University** in Public Health Dentistry under Dentists Act shall be eligible to become an Ordinary Member.

c) STUDENT MEMBER

Any person registered in Part A of the Indian Dentists Register and who is enrolled in Post-graduate (MDS) course in Public Health Dentistry **from any recognized Indian University** shall be eligible to become a student member of the Association. Such student member shall become Ordinary member/ Life member after obtaining post graduate degree by payment of the requisite fee prescribed

d) LIFE MEMBERS

Any person who is eligible to become an ordinary member and any existing ordinary member can become a Life Member by paying the requisite sum prescribed, at that time, He will continue to have all the privileges of an ordinary member.

e) ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

Any person who is qualified to become an Ordinary Member from abroad and who is approved by the Executive Committee shall be eligible to become an Associate Member.

f) AFFILIATE MEMBERS

Any person not being eligible to be enrolled as an Ordinary Member but who is interested in the study of Dentistry and is registered in Part A of the Indian Dentists Register and who is approved by

the Executive Committee of the Association shall be eligible to become an Affiliate Member of the Association. All dental degrees apart from MDS in Public Health Dentistry shall come in this clause.

g) HONORARY MEMBERS

The Executive Committee may nominate any person or persons to be Honorary Members of the Association for such a period as may be stipulated by the Executive Committee.

h) INSTITUTIONAL / CORPORATE MEMBERS

The Executive Committee may nominate Institutions/Corporate desirous of becoming members of the Association. Only those institutions related to the dentistry may be considered for membership.

i) EMERITUS STATUS

Any person whom the Executive Committee considers, has made outstanding contribution to the Association or Profession.

6. MODE OF BECOMING A MEMBER

Any person who has the requisite eligibility or an Institution/ Corporate desiring to become a member of the Association in one or the other of the class of membership shall make an application in writing in the form as may, from time to time, be prescribed by the Association to the Honorary General Secretary of the Association for the time being, setting out the particulars required and accompanied by the prescribed entrance-fee and annual subscription for the financial year of the Association. In the case of student membership, a bonafide certificate certifying him as a post-graduate student from the Head of the Institution where he/she is studying, shall have to be submitted.

Every application will be submitted by the Honorary General Secretary of the Association to the Executive Committee with the least possible delay. The Executive Committee shall have the absolute discretion to accept or reject any application without assigning any reason for the same.

In case of non-acceptance of the application, the entrance fee and the annual subscription, if any forwarded there with shall be refunded to the applicant concerned.

7. ENTRANCE FEE & ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION

The entrance fee and annual subscription payable by following class of members shall be decided by the Executive Committee

NOTES: “Founder Members” category is closed for membership. “Student Members” can become “Ordinary Members” after obtaining post graduate degree by paying Rs. 500/-. Student members can become Life members by paying remaining amount of Rs. 4000/- within six months from their date of passing. After six months they need to pay full amount i.e. Rs.7000/- to become life members. Institutional/ Corporate members- Such amount as may be decided by the Executive Committee after giving consideration to factors like nature, size of the institution and its relevance to the field of Dentistry and the Association. Defaulting members may pay the arrears and become ordinary members.

8. FINANCIAL YEAR

The financial year of the Association shall be from 1st of April to 31st of March.

9. WORKING HOURS

The Association will work on all weekly days between 9a.m. to 5p.m. except on Saturdays, Sundays and Government holidays.

10. REGISTER OF MEMBERS

The association shall cause to be kept a register in which shall be entered Name, address, qualifications, classification and status of each member. Every member shall forth with notify the Honorary General Secretary of any change in his/her name, address or qualifications. **(Annexure 1)**

11. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

A member shall cease to be a member of the Association if:

- a) The member tenders his/her resignation in writing to the Executive Committee, giving three months notice.
- b) The member has his/her membership removed on account of non-payment of subscription, unsound health, death and actions against the interest of the Association.
- c) Any member, so ceasing to be, shall forfeit all his/her rights to or claims upon or privileges of the Association, its properties and funds but shall, however continue to be liable for and pay to the association all money which at the time of his/her ceasing to be member of the Association be deemed from him/her to the Association.

12. PRIVILEGES OF MEMBERS

- a) All members of the Association shall be supplied with free soft copy of the journal of the Association.
- b) All members shall be entitled to the use of the library, website and Association rooms, if such facilities exist.
- c) All members shall have the right to attend and take part in discussions at all scientific meetings, lectures and demonstrations organized by the Association.
- d) Only Founder, Life and Ordinary members shall have the right to vote on all resolutions put forward at any meeting of the Association
- e) All members shall have the right to attend the conferences organized by the Association after due registration. However a member has a right to attend only the general body meeting if so desires.
- f) A copy of this constitution shall be supplied to all Members free, on admission.

13. CONSTITUTION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

10. EC members : 8 (Two reserved for ladies)

14. MODE OF ELECTION

The election of the members of the Executive Committee as aforesaid shall be held at the Annual General Meeting of the Association

The election of the President shall be held every one year. Therefore it follows that the terms of the President elect & Immediate Past President is also for a period of one year only. While issuing notice year should be mentioned

The election for all the other Office bearers & members specified shall be for a period of two years.

The following are the criteria for eligibility for the various posts.

- A member should be a member of good standing for at least three years before he contests for any post. Also a member can stand for election only as an EC member to begin with & cannot stand for any other post directly.
- Minimum attendance of three conferences & three AGMs within 5 years before the date of election mandatory for standing for any post. **(Annexure -2)**
- Minimum attendance of 50% of EC meetings mandatory to stand for any further posts
- After becoming EC member, the individual can contest for the posts of Editor, Treasurer, Joint Secretary, Hon. General Secretary only.
- Member should be an ordinary member at least for 6 years and as an EC member at least once for the post of Editor, Treasurer & Joint Secretary.
- Member should be an ordinary member at least for 10 years & as an EC member at least once for the post of Hon.Gen.Secretary.
- A member who has held any one of the above Office bearers posts(Editor, Treasurer, Joint Secretary, Hon. General Secretary) will only be eligible to stand for Vice President or President.
- For President & Vice President posts, member should be an ordinary member at least for 10 years and satisfy all the above criteria.
- No person should hold the same post for more than two terms, but they can hold two term continuously.
- If there are no eligible candidate for the two posts reserved for ladies in the Executive Committee & one post reserved for ladies as vice-President, the posts shall be open to all.

- Whenever two candidates acquire the same number of votes the outcome will be decided on the President's second or casting vote.

15. POWERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive Committee shall direct and regulate the general affairs of the Association and shall have the following powers.

- a) To frame, alter or repeal rules, bye-laws for the conduct of business at meetings of the Executive Committee and for the maintenance and administration of the Association room, library and properties and for the organizing and direction of conferences, conventions, workshops, CDE/CDH programmes, website, research activities and publications.

The Conferences & Conventions must be held as per protocol approved in the AGM. **Enclosed as Annexure 4 & 5.** The conferences shall be allotted region wise-North, South, East, West, Central by rotation & when there are no takers, anyone can bid for the same. (List of states in each zone given in table below). If there are no takers, then the Head Office will conduct the conference & AGM at Headquarters. CDE & CDH to work as in **Annexure 6.** Submission for grant for research must be as given in **Annexure 7.**

- b) To frame, alter or repeal rules and by-laws of the Association, subject to the approval of the annual general meeting of the Association.
- c) To appoint committees or sub-committees and standing committees, such as Scientific committee, Website committee, Working committee, Finance committee, Propaganda committee, Grievance committee, CDH/CDE committees, State representatives and other committees and Co-opt members as deemed necessary. The appointment of co-opted members is the prerogative of the President & Hon.Gen. Secretary. No member who has stood & lost in the elections just concluded may be inducted into any committee or co opted.
- d) To represent to the Government, public bodies or any constituted authority, any matter in which the interests of the Association or the Dental profession are affected.
- e) To consider and decide applications for direct membership, the resignation of members and the question of taking disciplinary action against member.
- f) To write-off the whole or part of the arrears against any individual member or a chapter or other out standings, if considered desirable.
- g) To delegate all or some of its powers to a working committee if and when appointed, except the power of altering rules and bye-laws.
- h) To appoint or remove salaried officers and employees of the Association.

- i) To exercise, in addition to the powers by the rules expressly conferred on it, all such powers and do all such acts and things as may be done by the Association and which are not hereby or by legislative enactment expressly directed or required to be exercised or done by the Association in general meeting.
- j) To purchase, take on lease or otherwise acquire, hold, manage, lend, exchange, sell, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of movable or immovable properties of every description and all rights or privileges necessary or convenient for the purposes of the association and, in particulars any land, building, furniture household or other effects, books, newspapers, periodicals, instruments, fittings, appliances, apparatus, conveyance and accommodation, and when deemed necessary or desirable in the interests of the Association, sell, demise, let, hire out, mortgage, transfer or otherwise dispose of the same.
- k) To erect, maintain, improve or alter and keep in repair any buildings for the purposes of the Association.
- l) To borrow or raise money in such manner as the Association may think fit and collect subscriptions and donations for the purposes of the Association.
- m) To permit to form State/Local chapters. All the chapters shall function within the frame work of the IAPHD constitution and Bye- laws. **Enclosed as Annexure 8(State) & 9(Local)**
- n) Each chapter will pay annually to the head office an amount as decided by the Executive Committee

16. FUNDS OF THE ASSOCIATION

The fund or the income of the Association shall be derived from the following sources.

- a) Subscription of the direct members and state/local chapters.
- b) Special contribution or donations received.
- c) Income derived from the Journal and other publications of the Association.
- d) Contributions received on account of organizing the conferences.
- e) Requests received by legacies from persons who desire to benefit and Association.
- f) Such other source as may be authorized by the Executive Committee

17. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING:

- a) Every meeting of the Executive Committee shall be called the least at 21 days notice in writing and preferably on Holiday. However emergency meeting can be called in consultation with the President with short notice. It is sufficient if notice is sent by E-mail.
- b) The quorum for every meeting of the Executive Committee shall be 3 members, of which at least one should be an office bearer.
- c) There shall be minimum of three Executive Committee meeting in every financial year. Any member who does not attend at least consecutive two EC Meeting without valid reasons is deemed to have vacated his seat.

18. CASUAL VACANCY IN THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

If there is any vacancy caused, the EC shall appoint to fill up the vacancy till the next annual general body meeting

19. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Association shall hold a General Meeting of its members called the Annual General Meeting within six months from the close of each financial year of the Association or during the National Conferences, at such time on such date and at such a place as may be determined by the Executive Committee. It shall be held on the second day of the three day National Conference. Two hours shall also be allotted for interaction between student members, life members & office bearers immediately after the AGM.

20. EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

All General Meetings other than the Annual General Meeting shall be called Extraordinary General Meeting. The Executive Committee may whenever it thinks fit call an Extraordinary General Meeting with 21 days notice.

21. REQUISITION OF EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

- a) The Executive Committee shall, on the requisition of such number of members of the Association as held in regard to any matter at the date of deposit of the acquisition by not less than one-fifth of the total strength of the members of the Association as at that date who carries right of voting in regard to the matter forthwith proceed with duty to call an extraordinary general meeting of the Association.
- b) The requisition shall set out the matters for consideration of which the meeting is to be called and shall be signed by the requisitionists and shall be deposited at the office of the Association.
- c) Where two or more distinct matters are specified in the requisition, the proceedings of sub-clause (a) above shall apply separately in regard to each such matter and the requisition shall accordingly be valid only in respect of those matter in regard to which the condition specified in that sub-clause is fulfilled.
- d) If the Executive Committee does not within 21 days from the date of the deposit of a valid requisition in regard to any matters, proceed duly to call a meeting for the consideration of those matters on a day not later than 45 days from the deposit of the requisition, the meeting may be called by the requisitionists as represent either a majority of not less than 1/5th of such of the members of the Association as is referred to in sub-clause (a) above, whichever is less.

A meeting called under sub-clause (d) above by the requisitionists or any of them shall be called in the same manner as nearly as possible as that in which meetings are to be called by the Executive Committee but shall not be held after the expiration of 90 days from the date of the deposit of the requisition. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed to prevent a meeting duly commenced before the expiry of 90 days aforesaid from being adjourned to some date after the expiry of that period.

The EOGM, if on requisition by individual requisitionists, shall be convened only at the head office. If there is no quorum at the given time the meeting shall stand dissolved. If the EC decides to convene an EOGM, the venue shall be decided by the EC. The quorum for the EOGM, convened by the EC, shall be at least 50% of the total strength. If there is no quorum at an EOGM called by the EC, within 30 minutes, it shall be adjourned and will be reconvened immediately at the same venue with the same agenda where quorum will not be necessary

22. NOTICE OF GENERAL MEETING

- a) A General Meeting of the Association may be called by giving not less than 21 days notice in writing.
- b) Every notice of the meeting of the Association shall specify the place, the date and hour of the meeting and shall contain the statement of business to be transacted there at.
- c) No General Meeting shall be competent to enter upon, discuss or transact any business which has not been specifically mentioned in the notice or notices upon which it was convened.

23. BUSINESS TO BE TRANSACTED AT ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Every Annual General meeting shall, amongst other business transact the following business relating to the consideration of accounts and the report of the Executive Committee.

The Agenda of the meeting shall be in the following order

- i. The election if necessary (in the absence of the President and the Vice Presidents) of a Chairman

Collaring the President

1. Welcome address by the President & calling the meeting to order.
2. Confirmation of minutes of previous Annual General Body/EOGM & action taken thereon.
3. Adoption of the Hon. General Secretary's annual report.
4. Adoption of the Journal Editor's annual report
5. Adoption of the annual report of the treasurer and the audited statement of accounts of the previous year ending 31st march (Head office accounts, National Conference, PG Convention, IAPHD Journal, State & Local branches)
6. Any other motion for change in the order of business.
7. Resolutions brought forward by EC.
8. Resolutions brought forward by the State/Local branches.
9. Resolutions brought forward by the individual members of the Association.
10. To consider & approve the programmes of activities for the following year.
11. To examine the proposal to host the National Conference & PG convention for the next year.
12. Placing the List of Prize winners in various categories
13. Any other matter with the permission of the chair (matters raised under this agenda shall only be discussed & appropriate action shall be taken after discussion in EC)
14. To appoint two scrutinizers for the election if any. **(Election notice template-Annexure 10, 11)**
15. Election of Office bearers & Executive Committee members.
16. Announcing of results & taking of office.
17. President's (outgoing) concluding remarks.
18. Incoming President's address.
19. Vote of thanks by Honorary General Secretary.

All members of the Head/State/Local branches/Individual members are requested to send their resolutions for discussion before 15th October failing which their resolutions will not be taken for discussion.

The Association issued bar coded ID cards must be produced while voting.

b. General Rules

- i. No resolution shall be placed before the AGM that has not been previously considered by the EC.
- ii. Resolutions to AGM, proposed by the individual members, duly signed and seconded by another member, shall be sent to the Honorary State Secretary, with a copy to the state/local branches, not later than 15th October.
- iii. Notice of resolutions to be moved at the AGM proposed by the EC of a state/local branch shall reach the Honorary State Secretary not later than 15th October.
- iv. The branch or the member sending the resolution has to be informed immediately after the EC meeting held or the same, whether their resolution has been accepted or rejected by the EC.
- v. The Hon. Gen. Secretary shall issue, with the notice of the AGM, the preliminary agenda showing the business to be brought before the meeting, the terms of all motions to be moved, of which notice in writing has previously reached him along with the names of the mover.
- vi. A member, who wishes to move an amendment to any item included in the agenda paper, or ask any question pertaining thereto shall give notice thereof to the Honorary Gen. Secretary so as to reach him not less than 7 clear days before the date fixed for the meeting. Members shall, however, have the right to propose amendment to any motion when it is before the house.
- vii. The Hon. Gen. Secretary shall make available to all members attending the meeting, a list of all amendments of which notice had been given.
- viii. A notice of a resolution or an amendment shall be invalid unless accompanied by a copy of such motion or amendment.
- ix. Any resolution of the EC of the State Branch may be considered at the AGM without notice being given.

c. General rules of procedure EC / AGM / EOGM

- i. Proceedings at the meetings of the Annual General Body shall be recorded in the form of typed minutes and after confirmation by the President/Chairman, at the next AGM, shall be permanently preserved.
- ii. No resolution adopted or negated at a meeting shall be reconsidered unless, either six months have elapsed, or 1/5 of the members of the EC, in case of branches, sign a requisition for such reconsideration.
- iii. The President / Chairman shall, in case of equality of votes, have a casting vote.
- iv. No business shall be transacted at a special meeting / EOGM other than that for which the meeting is called.
- v. The proceedings of any meeting, shall not be invalid by reason of there being a vacancy/ vacancies or any invalid appointment or election of any member or accidental omission to give notice of such meeting to any member.

- vi. A notice may be served on any member either personally through an employee of the Association or by post/ courier/ email, etc.

24. HOW NOTICE OF MEETING IS TO BE GIVEN

Notice of every meeting of the members of the Association shall be sufficiently given by e-mail and in website. The accidental omission to give notice of any meeting to or of the non-receipt of any Notice by a Member will not invalidate the proceedings at a meeting.

25. QUORUM OF GENERAL MEETINGS

- a) One-fourth of the member of members entitled to vote and present in person shall be quorum for General Meetings and no business shall be transacted at any General Meeting unless the quorum requisite be present at the commencement of the business.
- b) If within fifteen minutes from the time appointed for holding a meeting, quorum be not present, the meeting shall stand adjourned and again be called half an hour later on the same day at the same place. If at any adjourned meeting also a quorum be not present, the members present, whatever be their number, shall be the quorum and shall have the power to decide upon all matters which would properly have been disposed of at the meeting from which the adjournment took place.

26. CHAIRMAN OF GENERAL MEETINGS

The President of the Association or in his absence the Vice President shall be entitled to take the chair at every General Meeting or if there be no such President or the Vice President or if at any meeting the President or the Vice President shall not be present within 15 minutes after the time appointed for holding such meeting or is unwilling to act, the members of the Executive Committee present may choose a chairman and if default of their doing so the members present shall choose one of the members of the Executive Committee to be the chairman and if no member of the Executive Committee present be willing to take the chair, the members present shall choose one of the members to be the chairman.

27. PASSING OF RESOLUTION AT GENERAL MEETINGS

- a) At any General Meeting, only the Founder, ordinary and life members shall be entitled to vote.
- b) Voting shall be either by show of hands or by ballot or in such other manner as may, from time to time, be determined by the Executive Committee
- c) A declaration by the chairman that a resolution has or has not been carried either unanimously or by a particular majority, shall be conclusive.

28. CHAIRMAN'S POWER TO REGULATE POLL

The chairman of the meeting shall have the power to regulate the manner in which the poll shall be taken and the result of the Poll shall be deemed to be the decision of the meeting on the resolution of which the poll was taken.

29. ACCOUNTS AND REPORT

At every Annual General Meeting of the Association, there shall be laid before the members the annual accounts and Executive Committee's report thereon. The newly elected Treasurer should

present a provisional budget for next one year and take approval at the first EC meeting convened. The approval for the budget for the second year of the term should be taken at the AGM. However, in case of any unavoidable circumstances, EC can spend a maximum of rupees one lakh as a non budgetary allocation.

30. MANAGEMENT

The management of business and affairs of the Association shall be vested in the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall have powers to appoint a member from amongst its Founder members or Ordinary members to fill in a casual Vacancy

31. MEETINGS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive Committee may meet together at a meeting for the dispatch or business from time to time and shall so meet at least once in every three calendar months and they may adjourn or otherwise regulate their meetings and proceedings as they may deem fit.

32. CHAIRMAN OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The President, and failing him, the Vice-President, shall act as the Chairman of the meetings of the Executive Committee

33. DECISION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The question arising at any meeting of the Executive Committee shall be decided by a majority of votes and in case of an equality of votes the Chairman of the meeting shall have a second or a casting vote.

34. POWERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

President Emeritus

Has the same protocol as President. However President will preside over all meetings.

Immediate Past President

Will attend all EC meetings actively.

President:

The President chairs every general meeting and the meetings of the Executive Committee members.

President elect

Will attend all EC meetings actively.

Vice-President:

The Vice-President assumes the powers of the President in his absence

The person who gets more votes during the election shall be designated 1st Vice President & the other as 2nd Vice President. Seniority shall be in the same order. (President has a second or casting vote in case of a tie during the elections).

Honorary General Secretary:

All communications to and from the Association shall be done by the Hon. General Secretary. He can enter into any arrangement with the Govt. at the centre or the states in India or with any foreign Govt., Chamber of Commerce, Local Boards, Municipalities or with any other public or private

authorities that may further any of the objects of the Association. He can raise or secure the payments which may be required for the purposes of the Association in such manner as the Association may think fit. The running of the day to day affairs & the monetary transactions thereto involved shall be done by the Hon.General Secretary. He shall be the conference and convention coordinator for the Head Office & shall visit the venue as of when desired.

Joint Secretary

The Joint Secretary assumes powers of the Hon.General Secretary in his absence

Treasurer:

The treasurer shall manage the accounts of the association and present the annual report of accounts at the Annual General Meeting. Shall provide a provisional budget in consultation with the Hon.General Secretary for the ensuing year and take approval from AGM.

Editor:

The Editor shall publish from time to time, papers embodying dental research conducted by members independently or under the auspices of the Association and the Journal of Indian Association of Public Health Dentistry (JIAPHD). He shall also publish, print journals, periodicals, articles and other literature relating to problems, practice, methods, improvements and other matters related to Dentistry, as a whole and related to public health dentistry in particular.

Members:

The members shall participate actively in all the Executive Committee meetings

35. POWERS OF DELEGATION

The Executive Committee may delegate any of their powers to a committee consisting of such number of members of their body as they may think fit and may from time to time, revoke and discharge any such committee either wholly or in part and either as to persons and purposes, but every committee so formed shall, in exercise of the powers so delegated, conform to any regulations that may, from time to time, be imposed on it by the Executive Committee. All acts done by such committee in conformity with such regulations and in fulfillment of the purposes of their appointment but no otherwise shall have the force and effect as if done by the Executive Committee

36. RESOLUTION BY CIRCULATION

In case of urgency or hardship, a resolution may be passed by circulation through e-mail without the meeting of the Executive Committee or of a committee thereof and such resolution shall be as valid and of factual as a resolution duly passed at the meeting or the Executive Committee or a committee duly called and held. If no suggestions are received within 15 days for any mail, it may be taken as accepted & proceed appropriately.

37. MINUTES OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND GENERAL BODY

There shall be maintained minutes of all proceedings of the Executive Committee and of the General Meeting in the Minute book which shall be so entered within 14 days of the conclusion of each such meeting. Any such minutes kept as aforesaid shall be evidence of the proceedings recorded there in. Such minute-book shall be kept at the headquarters of the Association and shall be open to inspection of members subject to such reasonable restrictions as the Executive Committee may

impose. Entries of all discussions must be entered as expressed by each member & it should not be limited to only conclusions.

38. AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION

Any amendment to the Constitution of the Association shall be placed before the Executive Committee and General Body and upon the same being passed at the General Meeting by majority of not less than three-fourth number of the members present and having a right to vote, the same shall be deemed to have been passed for further action. It is then sent to the Founder members for approval. Thereafter, the governing body may submit the proposition to the members of the society in a written or printed report, and may convene a special Extraordinary General Body Meeting for the consideration thereof according to the rules and regulations of the society. But no such proposition shall be deemed to have been approved unless such report has been delivered or sent by post to every member of the society twenty-one days previous to the date of the special general meeting convened by the governing body for the consideration thereof, and unless such proposition shall have been agreed to by the votes cast in favour of the proposition by members who being entitled so to do, vote in person, or where proxies are allowed, by proxy, and such votes are not less than three times the number of the votes, if any, cast against the resolution by members so entitled and voting and confirmed by a similar majority of votes at a second special General Meeting convened by the governing body after an interval of thirty days after the former meeting. Every change in the memorandum of association approved shall be filed with the Registrar within thirty days from the date of making thereof and the Registrar may if he is satisfied that the change is in accordance with the provisions of this Act and the rules made thereunder register such change. Such change shall not have effect until it has been so registered.

39. DISSOLUTION OF THE ASSOCIATION

The Association shall be dissolved only by two-third majority of the members present and voting at the General Meeting. In case the Association is dissolved by the General Meeting, its assets shall be transferred to any other association having similar objects, as decided by the General Meeting. (Sec. 21 & 22 of KSR Act 1960)

CDE COMMITTEE

1. To organize national level **Teachers Training Program**, in the specialty of PHD once in a year.

 - b) A complete list of the speakers with their curriculum vitae is to be sent to the head office as soon as the speaker is finalized, for assessment.
 - c) To finalize the dates and topics for the programmes in consultation with the head office.
 - d) To make all arrangements for holding the programme.
 - e) To send invitations to all faculty members and others.
 - f) To send the finalised programme brochures to the head office for distribution to all dental institutions atleast three months before the dates of the programme.
 - g) After the programme is held, a detailed report of the programme, with evaluation analysis from the participants regarding the programme is to be sent to the head office and problems faced by the organizers and suggestions for improvement are also required to be sent.
 - h) To identify potential sponsorers for financial assistance of the program.
2. To conduct national level essay competitions.
3. To formulate plans for establishing and maintaining the highest attainable level of technical standards in teaching and promoting Public Health Dentistry and to submit such plans to head office.
4. To assist constituent chapters in obtaining and selecting speakers for their respective programs.
5. To make necessary recommendations to the head office for changes in the curriculum of Public Health Dentistry.

CDH COMMITTEE

- a. The duties of this committee shall be to establish and promote a dental health education program.
- b. To disseminate information on preventive dentistry and dental public health to the public, press, radio, television and other news media.
- c. To interpret the Public Health Dentistry and its goals to the public.
- d. To initiate public information programs, with the approval of the Executive Committee.
- e. To approach/assist interested public service organizations in establishment of preventive dental education programs and to coordinate with the head office for organizing oral health awareness programs at national level on special occasions like world health day etc.
- f. Preparation of materials for publication on public health education and Dental care such as pamphlets, films, film slides, postcards and exhibits, for the use of teachers and health education workers and for exhibition and distribution to the general public especially during the National Dental Health Week Celebration[if any], etc.
- g. To develop outreach projects regarding dental health

SCIENTIFIC COMMITTEE

2. To maintain a data bank of completed and ongoing thesis topics, library dissertations etc
3. To collect information regarding ongoing and completed research projects in the specialty of PHD in various colleges.
4. To convene scientific meetings / seminars at periodic intervals at convenient places as decided upon by the head office.
5. To promote academic activities through the voluntary help of postgraduate departments of various dental institutions in India and / or abroad.
6. To recognize outstanding research workers and institutes
7. To develop scientific reports, books, and articles for international scientific journals etc regarding the ongoing scientific activities of IAPHD

ANNEXURE - 7

IAPHD FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO BDS/MDS RESEARCH PROJECTS

IAPHD being a premier organization for fostering research among dental graduates and postgraduates is instituting a new scheme of providing financial assistance to selected dental graduates/postgraduate students and faculty who are in associated to recognized dental institutions. This scheme is primarily aimed at promoting good quality research in dental colleges through students and faculty and as well as improve visibility and accessibility of their research work to larger research audience.

The highlights of scheme are as follows :

1. The Association will provide a total financial assistance/year of Rs.50,000/- for 4 projects.
2. Number of Awards:Three for Staff/PG student of Rs.15,000 each & One for UG students for Rs.5,000/-

Procedure for selection:

1. Candidates must apply within 12 months of registration for the course.
2. The application should be routed through their guide and the head of the institution.
3. The candidate and the guide will indicate their choice of the research topic and will give a brief description of the objectives, methodology, design of the study, expected out come, Up-to-date literature search, ethical considerations and facilities available at the institute for conducting the study as per the proposed protocol and an undertaking by the head of the institute that the candidate will be permitted to undertake the proposed research activity.
4. Selection would be made on the basis of merit. Objective scoring would be used to assess the grant applications with respect to
 - i. Academic performance of the candidate
 - ii. Research topic (eg. Innovativeness, Relevance of work, Application Research) etc.

In the event of leaving this scheme the whole amount will be remitted to the council with suitable justifications.

5. The application for financial assistance should include, curriculum vitae of the candidates, description of the proposed research activity (1000 words) and a honest statement of the candidate about his/her dedication to the area of proposed research.
6. Selection will be done by an expert committee duly constituted for this purpose.

Financial Assistance:

1. The Association would provide a total assistance mentioned to the selected candidates 'on the condition' that the candidate would provide an undertaking to the effect that the funds received from the Association will be used strictly for the purpose for which it has been released and;
2. In the event of leaving this scheme the whole amount will be remitted to the Association with suitable justifications.
3. The grant shall be issued in the name of the candidate directly with a copy to the Guide and the Head of the Institute.
4. The amount will be used by the candidate for pursuance of research and may use the funds for purchase of reagents, preparation of thesis, secretarial assistance or any other activity connected with the research project following fair and reasonable procedure.
5. He will be required to provide information to the Association regarding the manner in which the funds were utilized duly signed by the Head of the Institute/college.

Monitoring:

Every attempt will be made by the Committee to identify a scientist from discipline appropriate to the research topic as a mentor, to monitor the project continuously till the research project is completed and reported. He will be in communication with the guide/ the student who will make periodic reports on the progress of the project and will give appropriate advice and guidance to the student for future course of action and mid-course correction, if needed. The monitor, the guide and the student should work as a team and ensure that the output is of reasonably good quality and can be reported in scientific journals.

Submission/Publication:

- a) The preparation and submission of research/thesis will be the responsibility of the student and his guide. The candidate will acknowledge the assistance provided by IAPHD for any publication emerging out of this thesis.
- b) The candidate should submit documents listed within three months of submission of thesis to the institution/organization failing which, The award will be treated cancelled and all financial assistance provided will be reimbursed to the IAPHD.
 - i. Selection of candidates at the sole discretion of the Association.
 - ii. The scheme can be withdrawn at any time.
 - iii. This scheme is not linked with any other research capacity building schemes under which the students are in receipt of stipend etc.

ETHICAL GUIDELINES

This statement of ethical guidelines for biomedical research on human participants shall be known as the IAPHD code and shall consist of the following:-

- (a) Statement of general principles on research using human participants in biomedical research
- (b) Statement of specific principles on research using human participants in specific areas of biomedical research. These statements of general and specific principles may be varied, amended, substituted and added from time to time.

PRINCIPLES:

Any research using the human beings as participants shall follow the principles given below –

I. **Principles of essentiality** whereby the research entailing the use of human participants is considered to be absolutely essential after a due consideration of all alternatives in the light of the existing knowledge in the proposed area of research and after the proposed research has been duly vetted and considered by an appropriate and responsible body of persons who are external to the particular research and who, after careful consideration, come to the conclusion that the said research is necessary for the advancement of knowledge and for the benefit of all members of the human species and for the ecological and environmental well being of the planet.

II. **Principles of voluntariness**, informed consent and community agreement whereby research participants are fully apprised of the research and the impact and risk of such research on the research participant and others; and whereby the research participants retain the right to abstain from further participation in the research irrespective of any legal or other obligation that may have been entered into by such human participants or someone on their behalf, subject to only minimal restitutive obligations of any advance consideration received and outstanding. Where any such research entails treating any community or group of persons as a research participant, these principles of voluntariness and informed consent shall apply, mutatis mutandis, to the community as a whole and to each individual member who is the participant of the research or experiment. Where the human participant is incapable of giving consent and it is considered essential that research or experimentation be conducted on such a person

incompetent to give consent, the principle of voluntariness and informed consent shall continue to apply and such consent and voluntariness shall be obtained and exercised on behalf of such research participants by someone who is empowered and under a duty to act on their behalf. The principles of informed consent and voluntariness are cardinal principles to be observed throughout the research and experiment, including its aftermath and applied use so that research participants are continually kept informed of any and all developments in so far as they affect them and others. However, without in any way undermining the cardinal importance of obtaining informed consent from any human participant involved in any research, the nature and form of the consent and the evidentiary requirements to prove that such consent was taken, shall depend upon the degree and seriousness of the invasiveness into the concerned human participant's person and privacy, health and life generally, and, the overall purpose and the importance of the research. Ethics committee shall decide on the form of consent to be taken or its waiver based on the degree of risk that may be involved.

III. **Principles of non-exploitation** whereby as a general rule, research participants are remunerated for their involvement in the research or experiment; and, irrespective of the social and economic condition or status, or literacy or educational levels attained by the research participants kept fully apprised of all the dangers arising in and out of the research so that they can appreciate all the physical and psychological risks as well as moral implications of the research whether to themselves or others, including those yet to be born. Such human participants should be selected so that the burdens and benefits of the research are distributed without arbitrariness, discrimination or caprice. Each research shall include an in-built mechanism for compensation for the human participants either through insurance cover or any other appropriate means to cover all foreseeable and unforeseeable risks by providing for remedial action and comprehensive aftercare, including treatment during and after the research or experiment, in respect of any effect that the conduct of research or experimentation may have on the human participant and to ensure that immediate recompense and rehabilitative measures are taken in respect of all affected, if and when necessary.

IV. **Principles of privacy and confidentiality** whereby the identity and records of the human participants of the research or experiment are as far as possible kept confidential; and that no details about identity of said human participants, which would result in the disclosure of their identity, are disclosed without valid scientific and legal reasons which may be essential for the purposes of therapeutics or other interventions, without the specific consent in writing of the human participant concerned, or someone authorised on their behalf; and after ensuring that the said human participant does not suffer from any form of hardship, discrimination or stigmatisation as a consequence of having participated in the research or experiment.

V. **Principles of precaution and risk minimisation** whereby due care and caution is taken at all stages of the research and experiment (from its inception as a research idea, its subsequent research design, the conduct of the research or experiment and its applicative use) to ensure that the research participant and those affected by it including community are put to the minimum risk, suffer from no known irreversible adverse effects, and generally, benefit from and by the research or experiment; and that requisite steps are taken to ensure that both professional and ethical reviews of the research are undertaken at appropriate stages so that further and specific guidelines are laid down, and necessary directions given, in respect of the conduct of the research or experiment.

VI. **Principles of professional competence** whereby the research is conducted at all times by competent and qualified persons who act with total integrity and impartiality and who have been made aware of, and are mindful of, preferably through training, the ethical considerations to be borne in mind in respect of such research or experiment.

VII. **Principles of accountability and transparency** whereby the research or experiment will be conducted in a fair, honest, impartial and transparent manner after full disclosure is made by those

associated with the research or experiment of each aspect of their interest in the research, and any conflict of interest that may exist; and whereby, subject to the principles of privacy and confidentiality and the rights of the researcher, full and complete records of the research inclusive of data and notes are retained for such reasonable period as may be prescribed or considered necessary for the purposes of post-research monitoring, evaluation of the research, conducting further research (whether by the initial researcher or otherwise) and in order to make such records available for scrutiny by the appropriate legal and administrative authority, if necessary.

VIII. **Principles of the maximization** of the public interest and of distributive justice whereby the research or experiment and its subsequent applicative use are conducted and used to benefit all human kind and not just those who are socially better off but also the least advantaged; and in particular, the research participants themselves and or the community from which they are drawn.

IX. **Principles of institutional arrangements** whereby there shall be a duty on all persons connected with the research to ensure that all the procedures required to be complied with and all institutional arrangements required to be made in respect of the research and its subsequent use or application are duly made in a bonafide and transparent manner; and to take all appropriate steps to ensure that research reports, materials and data connected with the research are duly preserved and archived.

X. **Principles of public domain** whereby the research and any further research, experimentation or evaluation in response to, and emanating from such research is brought into the public domain so that its results are generally made known through scientific and other publications subject to such rights as are available to the researcher and those associated with the research under the law in force at that time.

XI. **Principles of totality of responsibility** whereby the professional and moral responsibility, for the due observance of all the principles, guidelines or prescriptions laid down generally or in respect of the research or experiment in question, devolves on all those directly or indirectly connected with the research or experiment including the researchers, those responsible for funding or contributing to the funding of the research, the institution or institutions where the research is conducted and the various persons, groups or undertakings who sponsor, use or derive benefit from the research, market the product (if any) or prescribe its use so that, inter alia, the effect of the research or experiment is duly monitored and constantly subject to review and remedial action at all stages of the research and experiment and its future use.

XII. **Principles of compliance** whereby, there is a general and positive duty on all persons, conducting, associated or connected with any research entailing the use of a human participant to ensure that both the letter and the spirit of these guidelines, as well as any other norms, directions and guidelines which have been specifically laid down or prescribed and which are applicable for that area of research or experimentation, are scrupulously observed and duly complied with.

STUDY PROTOCOL APPLICATION:

1. The title with signature of Principal Investigator (PI) and Co- investigators as attestation for conducting the study.
2. Clear research objectives and rationale for undertaking the investigation in human participants in the light of existing knowledge.
3. Recent curriculum vitae of the investigators indicating qualification and experience.
4. Participant recruitment procedures and brochures, if any.
5. Inclusion and exclusion criteria for entry of participants.

6. Precise description of methodology of the proposed research, including sample size (with justification), type of study design (observational, experimental, pilot, randomized, blinded etc.), intended intervention, dosages of drugs, route of administration, duration of treatment and details of invasive procedures if any.
7. Plan to withdraw or withhold standard therapies in the course of research.
8. Plan for statistical analysis of the study.
9. Procedure for seeking and obtaining informed consent with sample of patient information sheet and informed consent forms in English and local languages.
10. Safety of proposed intervention and any drug or vaccine to be tested, including results of relevant laboratory, animal and human research.
11. For research involving more than minimal risk, an account of management of such risk or injury.
12. Proposed compensation and reimbursement of incidental expenses and management of research related and unrelated injury/ illness during and after research period.
13. An account of storage and maintenance of all data collected during the trial.
14. Plans for publication of results - positive or negative - while maintaining the privacy and confidentiality of the study participants.
15. A statement on probable ethical issues and steps taken to tackle the same like justification for washout of standard drug, or the use of placebo control..
16. All other relevant documents related to the study protocol like investigator's brochure for trial on drugs/ devices/ vaccines/ herbal remedies and statement of relevant regulatory clearances.
17. Agreement to comply with national and international Good Clinical Practices (GCP) protocols for clinical trials.
18. Details of funding agency/ sponsors and fund allocation.
19. For international collaborative study details about foreign collaborators and documents for review of Health Ministry's Screening Committee(HMSC) or appropriate committees under other agencies/ authority like Drug Controller General of India (DCGI)
20. For exchange of biological material in international collaborative study a MoU/ Material Transfer Agreement between the collaborating partners.
21. A statement on conflict-of-interest (COI), if any.

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR FORMATION OF STATE BRANCH OF IAPHD.

The State Branch is that branch of the Association which has its jurisdiction within the state territory and shall cover all members of the State or Union Territory. It shall be made up of various local branches within the same territory and shall have its office headquarters within the same State/Union Territory where the Hon. State Secretary resides/practices. Every state branch will act as the co-ordinating link between the HO and local branches. It will oversee the functions and activities of its local branches. The state branch shall function under the auspices of the HO and abide by the rules and regulations of the HO who may de-recognize it for breach of rule or condition of the byelaws.

The State branch will be subservient to the constitution of the IAPHD and the state branch shall be called the IAPHD 'State' Branch and no other name, for example IAPHD Tamilnadu State Branch and shall exhibit the logo of the IAPHD only.

Any member of the IAPHD can be a member of only one branch, either his place of native or work. Whenever he shifts from one branch to another, he must inform the Head office & only on receipt of the confirmation of the same can his transfer be accepted. The voting rights are vested with his local/state membership.

1. Formation

- a. The members residing and practicing in an individual state (if there are no local branches), or the Presidents/Secretaries or members of local branches in a state shall unite to form a state branch on a territorial basis.
- b. The members or Presidents/Secretaries of the local branches should sign a written document, proposing to start the branch, mentioning the name, address and membership number. They will elect their office bearers and shall forward the complete proposal to the HO for approval. After verification the HSG will put the proposal before the EC for final approval. On approval, the HSG will inform the President and Hon. State Secretary to officially commence the functioning of the state branch. The President & Hon. Gen. Secretary of the Head office should be invited & shall be present at the Inauguration.
- c. There will be only one state branch in a State/Union Territory.
- d. The general management of the state branches shall be vested with the EC of the branch, under guidance from HO.
- e. Every state chapter should be registered locally and get a separate PAN card for that chapter
- f. No one in receipt of salary or honorarium from the funds of the Association can be elected as office bearer of the Association.
- g. Defense wing officers serving in the Army or any of its wings under the Army Dental Corps may if they wish form a separate branch which may be considered a state / regional branch. All the rules shall apply to the defense branch except the minimum number of members.
- h. The list of members in each state shall be sent to the secretariat on before the 31st of January each year
- i. In case of dispute or conflict the decision of the National EC shall be final. Such arbitration shall be governed by the provisions of the Indian Arbitration Act.

2. Management:

A. Executive Committee (EC).

The general management of the state branch as a whole shall be vested with the EC of the branch, under guidance from HO. No one in receipt of salary or honorarium from the funds of the Association can be elected as office bearer of the Association.

The National President and Hon. Gen. Secretary shall be ex-officio members of all state / regional Executives and shall be invited to attend all meetings and functions at their own expense.

The state branch office will look after all the activities linked to its respective state. It will guide the local branches, which are affiliated to it, in all matters and shall become the medium of communication between local branches and HO

The State Executive Committee shall regulate the general affairs of the Association and work within the framework of the Constitution and as per the directive of the HO

C. Term of Office

- a. The EC shall enter upon its duties at the close of the AGM of the state branch and shall hold office till the next AGM of the state branch or till 31st December, whichever is earlier.
- b. The Office Bearers and members shall function forthwith after election and shall continue as members till the end of their tenure as mentioned in the constitution.
- c. Any member of the EC who is absent for three consecutive meetings without assigning a valid, reason, apology in writing, shall cease to be a member of the EC, automatically. Notice to such members shall not be sent for the next EC meeting. Such members shall not be eligible for re-election, re-nomination for that Association year.

5. Meetings:

A. Executive Committee Meeting

A notice of 21 days shall be given to members. However, in case of urgent meetings, the notice shall be of seven days. The exact date and time (between 9.00 am to 5.00pm only), shall be fixed by the Hon. State Secretary in consultation with State President. In the absence of a quorum within 30 minutes of the appointed time, the meeting shall be adjourned. The adjourned meeting shall be held immediately at the same venue with the same agenda where quorum will not be necessary.
- b. A special requisition meeting of the EC shall be called within 4 weeks, on receipt of the requisition signed by at least 3 members of the EC, stating the business for which a special meeting is required. Notice for such a meeting shall be given 14 days in advance and the quorum shall be members of the EC, out of which at least 2 members shall be from amongst the requisitionists'. In the absence of a quorum, within 30 minutes of the appointed time, the special requisition meeting shall be dissolved.
- c. Proceedings of the meetings of the EC shall be recorded in the form of typed minutes and after confirmation shall be permanently preserved. The Executive Committee minutes shall be sent to all state Executive Committee members along with the notice and agenda for the next Executive Committee meeting. Any correction by state Executive Members should reach Hon. State Secretary at least three days prior to the date of the Executive Committee Meeting. If no correction is received by the State Secretary, at least three days before the next EC, either by reg. post/courier/email, no correction shall be permitted at the EC meeting unless approved by the President. This register shall be kept in the State Secretary's Office and shall be open to members of the State Executive Committee for inspection.

B. Annual General Body Meeting

It is compulsory for all branches to conduct their AGM between 1st November and 31st December every year and make known the election results to HO. If a state branch does not conduct its AGM and election by 31st December, the President of Head Office shall assume office automatically as President on 1st January. He shall then issue a notice of the AGM and elections of office bearers, whose tenure is over by that time and he shall be the returning officer for the Election. Head office shall send an observer for that election

President has the right to intimate the bank, informing names of the newly elected office bearers who are authorised to operate branch accounts hence forth. Outgoing office bearers cease to operate the bank accounts with immediate effect. He shall inform the election result to HO and to all members of the branch. The notice of AGM shall be sent at least 28 days in advance. The quorum required for the state branch AGM is 50%. In the absence of a quorum within 30 minutes of the appointed time, the meeting shall be adjourned. The adjourned meeting shall be held immediately at the same venue with the same agenda where quorum shall not be necessary.

6. Funds/Finance:

- a. The state branch is independent on its own with regard to finance, purchase of movable and/or immovable assets and formation of a trust/charitable trust.
- b. If a state branch closes down or suspends its activities or is de-recognized, its funds including cash securities, fixed deposit certificates, etc., shall forthwith be transferred to the HO, to be kept in a Trust. It will not be annexed or clubbed with any funds of the HO.
- c. The accounts of the state branch shall be scrutinized, audited and approved by its EC and circulated to members before being placed at the respective AGM of the state branch. One copy of the audited and approved statement of accounts shall be forwarded to HO every year after the AGM.
- d. The funds of the state branch shall be invested in the manner as specified in section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act. This Association is an irrevocable Association. However, if this Association becomes defunct or dissolved, the assets/ funds of the Association shall be vested with the Headf office. There shall not be any activity of the state branch with the intention of earning any profit. The funds of the state branch/ Association shall be solely utilized towards the objectives and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to its members by way of profit, interest, dividend etc.
- e. Funds of the state branch / Association, irrespective of what-ever head they come under, CDH, CDE, Journal, etc, shall be received only by the Treasurer and credited to respective heads of A/c maintained with the state branch. He may pay cash as advance to an office bearer of the above sections as approved by EC or on reimbursement basis on receipt of vouchers.
- f. Funds and all bank accounts and other accounts shall be operated and handled by the Treasurer jointly with the State Secretary of the State branch.

A. Income

The funds or the income of the state branch shall be derived from the following sources:

- a. State share of subscription from the local branches on account of the members on their rolls.
- b. Special contributions or donations raised by the state branch.
- c. Income derived from the journal and other publications of the Association.
- d. Contributions received on account of organising state conferences or CDE.
- e. Bequeaths received by legacies from persons who desire to assist the Association.
- f. Sponsorships and such other sources as may be authorised by the EC.
- g. Surplus from conferences, if any.
- h. Surplus funds from CDE/CDH programmes if any.

B. Reserve Fund

There shall be a reserve fund of the state branch. The reserve fund shall be 50% of the net surplus income of the first year of the branch concerned. In addition, 25% of the net surplus should be credited to this fund every year. The reserve fund shall only be drawn upon by a special resolution of a meeting of the EC, in which 3/4 of the member's present and who cast their vote, vote in favour of the resolution of withdrawal.

C. Bank Accounts

Bank Accounts under various heads shall be opened only on approval of the EC and shall be operated by the Hon. Treasurer jointly with the Hon. Branch Secretary.

D. Head of Accounts

All accounts/financial matters of the state branch shall be handled only by the state office. All receipts pertaining to CDE, CDH, journal and any other activity shall be received by the local state office Treasurer and remitted under respective heads. No other office bearer except conference accounts (optional, to be decided by State EC) shall operate independent accounts in a bank. The Hon. Treasurer shall maintain various heads of accounts of income and expenditure. All income shall be payable to the Treasurer State Office and it shall be credited into respective head of accounts. Similarly on the expenditure side, the Hon. Treasurer shall debit the expenses on the respective head of account and issue a demand draft on the advice of the convenor CDH/CDE, Editor, etc., and other conveners, if any, and debit it to the Head of Account. In case of state branches, all funds, all bank accounts and all other accounts shall be handled and operated by the respective Treasurer of the branch, jointly with the Hon. State Secretary of the branch.

E. Expenditure

The EC, in the case of state branches shall out of the funds of the branch, debit all ordinary expenses and shall pay rents, salaries, wages and such other charges as may be necessary for carrying out the work of the Association. It shall, further provide for the issue of the journal of the Association and such other publications as may be authorised and shall be empowered to spend money on scientific investigations, seminars, conferences, prizes, scholarships and on such other purposes as it may consider advisable in furtherance of the objectives of the Association.

All major expenses in excess of Rs.50, 000/- other than routine administrative expenses shall require an approval from the EC.

F. Audited Accounts

- a. The annual statement of accounts and the balance sheet, for the period starting 1st April and ending 31st March of every year, after auditing, shall be submitted to the EC and after approval by the EC, shall be circulated to members and placed at the AGM, by the Treasurer and the Hon. Secretary.
- b. Similarly state branch conference accounts shall be audited by the state branch auditor and approved by the respective State EC.

G. Appointment of an Auditor

- a. A Chartered Accountant shall be appointed as auditor at the AGM of the state branch every year for auditing its accounts.
- b. Duties of the auditor for the State Branch
 - a. Audit the accounts at the end of the year, and certify that they are accurate and correct.
 - b. Shall assist and give suggestions for proper book keeping of accounts as required.

H. Liability

Neither the IAPHD nor any of its branches shall be liable for any of the debts or liabilities of one another.

7. Records

The State Branch will maintain the following records:

- a. A register/computerized database of members with their membership number, name, qualification, current residence/ mailing address and the branch they belong to.

- b. Account books, ledgers, cash books shall be retained up to a period of 8 years after which they can be destroyed. Audited balance sheets of all years shall be retained.
- c. Correspondence beyond years may be destroyed at the discretion of the Hon. State Secretary.
- d. The AGM, E.O.G.M. & EC minutes, attendance registers of EC, AGM & E.O.G.M., membership registers and important correspondence shall be retained permanently.

Failing to follow any of the above mentioned Bye-laws, National AGM has every right to take appropriate action for proper functioning of state chapters. The EC has the right to withdraw recognition by a 2/3 majority. This will not affect the membership status of the individual members. A state branch may be derecognized if found to be acting against the interest of IAPHD

ANNEXURE - 9

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR FORMATION OF LOCAL BRANCH OF IAPHD

The Local Branch is that branch, which is demographically located within the boundaries of a town, city, district, or municipal corporation.

Any member of the IAPHD can be a member of only one branch, either his place of native or work. Whenever he shifts from one branch to another, he must inform the Head office & only on receipt of the confirmation of the same can his transfer be accepted. The voting rights are vested with his Branch/State membership.

1. Formation

The Public Health Dentists of an individual town/city/district/municipal corporation where a minimum of 20 or more members are practicing or residing, shall come together and form/constitute a local branch. They will specify the name of their branch, as adopted by their branch members and declare their area of operation.

The members require to sign a written proposal, stating their intention of starting a branch, mentioning therein the serial no, membership no., if any, name, address and their existing branch, if any. They will elect their office bearers and shall forward the complete proposal to the HO. After verification the HSG will put the proposal before the EC for final approval. On approval, the HSG will inform the President and Hon. Local Secretary to officially commence the functioning of the Local branch. The President & Hon. Gen. Secretary of the Head & State office should be invited & shall be present at the Inauguration.

More than one local branch can be formed in an area, provided that the parent local branch has more than 500 Annual/ Life Members and the members practicing within the stipulated area agree to form another local branch.

In case a state branch is not functioning, local branches within the state shall be permitted by the CC to function directly under the HO.

If the local branch strength reduces to less than the minimum prescribed after recognition, the branch shall still be permitted to continue as a local branch.

Every local chapter should be registered locally and get a separate PAN card for that chapter

No one in receipt of salary or honorarium from the funds of the Association can be elected as office bearer of the Association

The list of members in each state shall be sent to the secretariat on before the 31st of January each year

In case of dispute or conflict the decision of the National EC shall be final. Such arbitration shall be governed by the provisions of the Indian Arbitration Act.

2. Management:

A. Executive Committee (EC).

The general management of the local branch as a whole shall be vested with the EC of the branch, under guidance from HO. No one in receipt of salary or honorarium from the funds of the Association can be elected as office bearer of the Association.

- f. Proceedings of the meetings of the Executive Committee shall be recorded in the form of typed minutes and after confirmation shall be permanently preserved. The EC meeting minutes shall be circulated to EC members along with the EC notice; and corrections if any shall be done at the time of confirmation. This register shall be kept in Secretary's office and shall be open to members of EC for inspection.

B. Annual General Body Meeting:

- a. It is compulsory for the Hon. Branch Secretary to issue and circulate to all members the notice of the AGM at least 21 days in advance, to conduct the AGM between 1st November and 31st December every year and to intimate the election result to HO and State office.
- b. If a local branch does not conduct its AGM and election by 31st December, the President Elect of the Branch shall assume office as President on 1st of January following his election.
- c. He shall then issue notice for the AGM and conduct elections to elect office bearers, if their tenure as local branch office bearers has expired by that time, and he shall be the returning officer for election.

The funds of the Local Branch / Association shall be solely utilized towards the objectives and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to its members by way of profit, interest, dividend etc.
- e. Funds and all bank accounts and other accounts shall be operated and handled by the Treasurer jointly with the local branch Secretary of the branch.

A. Income

- a. By the subscription of the members of the branch concerned after forwarding the HO and State share.
- b. Special contributions or donations raised directly.
- c. Income derived from the journal and other publications of the branch, if any.
- d. Share received on account of organising the National/ State Conference.

- f. By sponsorship and such other sources as may be authorised by the branch EC.
- g. Surplus from conferences, if any.

The EC has the right to withdraw recognition by a 2/3 majority. This will not affect the membership status of the individual members. A local/state branch may be derecognized if found to be acting against the interest of IAPHD
